

THE FOUNDING MYTH

Every winter from 1931 till 1964...

In 1929, in response to the economic crisis, a group of intrepid winegrowers joined forces under a motto that sums up everything they stood for: "A la tête par la main" (Together we can make it happen!)

Every winter from 1931 till 1964 they dug by hand, 19 metres below the surface, a kilometre of chalk crayères. Each grower, in accordance with the size of its estate, had to offer 10 working days per 2,5 acres.

These pioneers built cellars in the heart of the chalk which are today the ideal place for ageing our bottles...

HAUTE VALEUR ENVIRONNEMENTALE & VITICULTURE DURABLE EN CHAMPAGNE

Since 2015, MAILLY Grand Cru Champagne and its winegrowers have been involved in a project that aims to implement sustainable viticulture more respectful of the environment and protection of its water resources.

Today, wine-growing practices are evaluated and recognised through a double certification: HVE (Haute Valeur Environnementale) VDC (Viticulture Durable en Champagne)

Beyond the regulatory requirements, the winegrowers commit to evaluating and improving their practices via indicators, around three main themes

MAINTAINING BIODIVERSITY: growing hedgerows, providing habitat for wildlife & cessation of chemical insecticide.

SOIL MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF THE VINEYARDS: ground cover, green fertiliser, ploughing, favouring biological & natural actions, aeration of foilage...

MANAGEMENT OF ORGANIC MATTER: soil analysis, abandon of mineral fertilisation...

87% of the vineyard is now certified. 100% in the near future.
